Second Stage and Long-Term Housing

Bravestone Centre - 204-275-2600

provides women and their children affected by domestic violence with secure and safe on-site housing, individual and group therapeutic counselling, support programs, advocacy, and connection with community resources.

Alpha House - 204-982-2011

Alpha House provides long term living for women and their children who have left abusive situations. Residents live in Alpha House for up to nine months while participating in one on one, children's counselling and support groups

L'Entre Temps - 204-925-2550

Protective housing & domestic abuse recovery program for women and children (can stay up to 1 yr.).

Native Women's Transition Centre - 204-989-8240

Long-term residence that provides care for Aboriginal victims of family violence (women & children).

Betty Berg House: Provides safe housing and various services to women recovering from addictions.

Chris Tetlock Place: Second stage transition housing facility and home to North End Women's Centre's addictions program.

Mary's House: Second-stage safe housing for women and children who have been victims of domestic violence; can stay from 6-18 months.

Age & Opportunity: Safe Suite - 204-956-6440

For men and women aged 55+ who need a safe place to stay due to abuse or neglect (up to 60 days).
